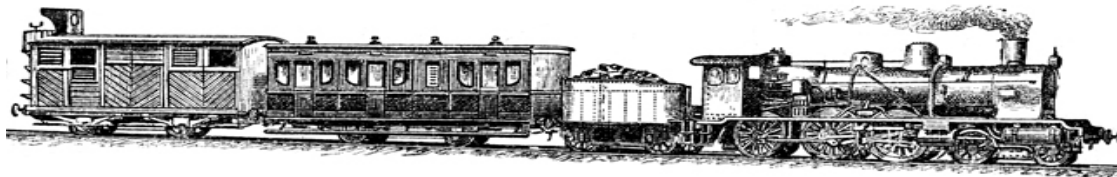

All aboard !

Cowboys & cowgirls jump on that steam train headed west and join us for the 10th annual Shootout at the Ridge in Mission B.C. Partake in the plethora of sensational side matches planned for the afternoon of Friday May 21st. The first try at each side match is included in your main match fee. Punch cards may be purchased at the shoot to *try again* and will afford you a chance to win the *I bought it award* for that event. The main match consisting of ten challenging stages will be held Saturday and Sunday with plenty of socializin' and banter mixed in.

The shoot entry fee provides a whole weekend of fun, including the main match of ten stages, ten side matches, and an entry into the prize table (if received by April 30th). The prize table will be scaled back slightly, but rest assured there will be some tantalizing items up for draw. All catered lunches and dinners are at the discretion of the shooter. You and your guests are invited to pre-purchase delicious catered dinners at \$20 p.p. and catered lunches at \$12 p.p. The meals include food and beverage of your choice plus coffee & tea. Remember to pre-order your lunches and dinners on your entry forms, as they will not be available for purchase at the shoot.

All categories are offered with a minimum of three pre-registered per class except juniors and buckaroos. The Buckaroo class will be combined with juniors. Buckaroos accompanied by a registered adult may shoot for free. Adult entry fee is \$85 and juniors are \$65. The maximum number of shooters is 85, so please sign up early.

As usual, ample free on-site camping and dry RV parking is offered. The clubhouse washroom and shower facilities will be available for the whole weekend. The RV camping area is our large gravel parking lot with plenty of room for any size RV unit. Pets are welcome but are restricted to the campsites or RV, absolutely no pets allowed on the ranges or in the clubhouse.

This year the Canadian Firearms Possession and Acquisition (PAL) exams will be offered by Aspen Sam of The Bullet Barn. Both the Non-restricted (Long guns) and Restricted (Handguns) exams will be offered on Friday May 21. It is a great opportunity for you to obtain your PAL as a Canadian citizen or as a USA citizen wishing to attend shoots in Canada. Cost is \$20 per exam. The side match format has also been changed to better accommodate more shooters and hopefully make them even more enjoyable. On Friday afternoon, all side matches will be offered simultaneously, so you can drift around, shoot them in any order you wish and even hang around to heckle your pards !
